Prepare Your Recyclables

RINSE

If not rinsed food debris causes odor and bacteria. Contamination may cause materials to be rejected and sent to the landfills.

FLATTEN

Save space by flattening boxes, cans and plastic, Please do not break glass containers.

LEAVE LIDS ON PLASTIC RECYCABLES, off of cartons and glass. No need to remove labels. Remove lids from mixed materials such as cartons (milk, juice, soup, wine, and broth). Metal lids are recycled with cans.

SEPARATE

The recycling bins are divided into two different sections. Please use the correct section to avoid contamination. The LEFT side of bin is for mixed recyclables: plastic bottles, jugs and dairy food containers; cans, cartons, and glass. The RIGHT side of bin is for cardboard and paper only. Curbside users do not need to separate, but please make sure to prep items correctly. Please note a few locations have a Cardboard Only bin.

PAPER



Cardboard should fit inside cart.

PLASTICS

Bottles, jugs, tubs and cups



Reattach lid. Yogurt and fruit cups OK.

METAL CANS & CUPS



Non-hazardous, non-flammable material only.

GLASS BOTTLES & JARS



Any color.

CARTONS



Remove caps and straws.

*Flatten cardboard *Rinse, crush, and reattach plastic lids *Remove lids from glass bottles

Do Not Bag Recyclables. No Food or Liquid. No Plastic Bags or Wrap. No Wires, Hoses, or Chains. No Clothing. No Dishes.
