

TRASH TALK



- **2 Bag System:**
Black Trash Bag = Trash
Clear/White Bag = Recycling
- * *Items must be semi clean* in order to be recycled. If questionable, dispose in trash.
* Acceptable recyclable items in Morrow County: Aluminum cans, Cardboard, Cartons, Glass bottles and jars, Paper, Plastic Bottles, Jugs and Tubs and Jugs, Steel/metal food cans.
- **Bulk items**
Possible categories of bulk items include: Tires; Scrap Metal (for recycling); Bulk Trash items such as couches, mattresses, large toys, etc. Group like material together to speed up the unloading process.
- **Remove** as much sand, gravel, mud, fluid, from any collected items as you possibly can.

DISPOSAL

Complete the 2024 Recycling and Trash Collection Form (submit by June 7, 2024)

THIS FORM IS MANDATORY FOR ALL PARTICIPANTS! By completing this form, you are assisting Morrow County Recycling/Keep Morrow County Beautiful with data needed for future grant funding for Trash Bash. This form also allows you to dispose of trash and recyclables at Mid-Ohio Sanitation and Recycling. However, **you must contact Kristin at 419-946-6400 to schedule your Mid-Ohio disposal and to receive cost assistance. You must also be a registered participant.** Mid-Ohio Sanitation and Recycling is located at 356 HPM Street, Mt. Gilead. Hours of Operation: Monday-Thursday 8AM-4:30PM, Friday 8AM-3PM, Closed Saturday and Sunday. Please plan accordingly. Only Registered Participants may use this service to dispose of collected litter.

If you do not wish to **dispose of your trash** directly through Mid-Ohio you may choose: Home Disposal – please utilize a certified waste hauler – or you may contact your local Township Trustee to see if you can utilize their disposal options.

Options for disposal of recyclables: All recyclables may be placed in the closest recycling bin if they are not taken to Mid-Ohio Sanitation and Recycling (please read above). Visit <https://morrowcountyohio.gov/recycling> for list of accepted recyclables. Also, you can sell sorted aluminum cans and scrap metal to a certified recycling center.

No matter how you dispose of your trash or recyclables, call 419-946-6400 to return your Recycling and Trash Collection Forms and your supplies. Return all safety vests, book bags, trash grabbers, unused or washed gloves, signage and/or other miscellaneous items.
