

The following action was taken by the Lincoln Township Trustees during regular session on April 4th, 2017.

RESOLUTION 2017-1: IN THE MATTER OF AMENDMENTS TO THE LINCOLN TOWNSHIP ZONING CODE:

WHEREAS, on April 4th, 2017, the Lincoln Township Trustees held a public hearing to discuss the recommended changes to the Lincoln Township Zoning Code submitted by the Lincoln Township Zoning Commission; and


WHEREAS, proposed changes to the Zoning Code are as follows:

- Delete number 1 in Section X
- Change number 5 in Section X to state: No lot shall be more than 3 times deeper than its width, with the width being the front lot line or that portion which runs along the street, road, or highway. This ruling to apply only up to CAUV requirements of 10 acres. This requirement does not apply to lots over 10 acres or more with a minimum of 300 feet of continuous road frontage.

THEREFORE, Mr. Brown moved and Mr. Brandum seconded to approve the changes to the Lincoln Township Zoning Code. Roll Call; Brown yea, Brandum yea, Pearl yea. The changes will take effect 30 days after passage of this resolution.


